Recognize = regard in some translations = consider, perceive, pay attention to, observe, examine

John 1:19-23 "Now this is the testimony of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, "Who are you?" He confessed, and did not deny, but confessed, "I am not the Christ." They asked him, "Who then? Are you Elijah?" He said, "I am not." "Are you the Prophet?" He answered, "No." They said to him then, "Who are you?
