SUNDAY'S THOUGHT

Living within the margins with money, in light of Galatians 5:23, focuses on the concept of self-control, which is one of the fruits of the Spirit.

To **live within the margins** means managing money with intention and foresight, creating a buffer between income and expenses. It reflects a heart that prioritizes financial stability, savings, and generosity.

Galatians 5:23 call for self-control reminds believers that a Spirit-led life is one of wisdom, balance, and trust in God's provision. By **living within the margins**, believers show they are good stewards of what God has entrusted to them, making decisions that reflect contentment, humility, and faith in God's guidance and sufficiency rather than seeking fulfillment in material wealth or status.

But the fruit that comes from having the Holy Spirit in our lives is: love, joy, peace, not giving up, being kind, being good, having faith, being gentle, and being the boss over our own desires.


