In **Luke 4** Jesus demonstrates His inclusive love and authority to heal and transform lives. His message is met with hostility from the Nazareth crowd, demonstrating the resistance to this broader vision of salvation.

Still, the message transcends boundaries, inviting both Jews and Gentiles (**Us**) into God's salvation plan. This passage emphasizes the universal nature of Jesus' ministry and the expansive reach of God's love.


