In contrast, God's plan, as revealed through Jesus, is to offer abundant life, characterized by spiritual fulfillment, peace, and eternal salvation. This verse highlights the stark difference between the destructive intentions of Satan and the life-giving mission of Jesus.

As believers, we must choose to align with God's purpose and resist the enemy's schemes.


