Attached to this message, you will find a copy of the 'reminder' document for our December meeting to keep you on track for our December gathering.

Thank you for your 'agenda flexibility' this past Monday. It was a shame we did not get to our Bible study video with Liz! However, it did reveal some important insights for our future gatherings.

To ensure gatherings move along more smoothly going forward, please read below:

1) Remember to select your refreshments immediately upon arrival and select your seat.

2) Our regular meeting start time is 6:30PM. Opening Devotion should begin no later than 6:45; once everyone is seated, the person with the devotion will begin.

3) The Bible videos will start *immediately following* the opening devotion.

Most videos are 12 minutes in length. Generally we need ~ 30-40 minutes to complete the discussion questions. With that timing in mind, we should complete our study within 45 minutes.

4) All other discussion topics/general conversation, will follow upon completion of video/discussion session.

I hope this change of logistics is comfortable for all? I (Bev) am suggesting the change because I recognize some people may need to leave a gathering a bit early from time to time and none of us want to miss the video!
