



Calvary Chapel H2H Groups - Child Care Guidelines

The consideration of children will be one of the most important aspects of the establishment of our House2House ministry. We will strive for an organized, well planned and orderly environment for all the groups, including those with children in attendance.

To provide a framework that is somewhat consistent from group to group, and to clearly outline what this environment looks like. Here are some guidelines:

- There should be adult supervision of children at all times.
- Children will be asked to leave all electronic devices at home or with parents during the entire small group gathering.
- The general expectation is for children to be included in fellowship and worship time with adults (which will be the majority of the gathering).
- While parents are enjoying 30-40 min. of study/discussion, there will be an engaging program planned and provided for a volunteer to lead with the children. This will coincide directly with the sermon-based study of the adults.
- Ideally, we will have a volunteer leader for each group containing children. This person will devote themselves weekly to ministering to the kids for the duration of the group (3 months). If there is not a specific person for this role, then parents should rotate weekly.
