Provide constructive input for improvements and changes that benefit the hospitality team and the church family. Be available for events as needed, i.e., BBQ, Luncheons and New To The Fellowship (NTTF).

- Ability to work independently with little supervision and follow guidelines established

### **Responsibilities**

1. Arrange for someone to take your place for scheduled event if unable to attend. If unable to make scheduled time, and unable to find a replacement – notify leader asap
2. Meet with Hospitality Leader every week to discuss needs, concerns and repairs
3. Make recommendations to improve systems in place for all members of the team
4. Attend monthly meetings and communicate gracefully to affect positive problem-solving results
5. Lead by example - model the grace, love, and humility of Jesus in all you do
6. Be committed to the hospitality team members and help grow them skillfully and spiritually
7. Be aware of sanitary requirements and wash hands, use gloves when serving to be safe
8. Recruit other team members and arrange for them to meet with leader
9. Meet with Hospitality Leader as requested to prepare for upcoming events
10. Assist in set-up, cooking, serving, breakdown and clean-up for events
11. Be welcoming and engage with persons at events
