Mission

While serving the body of Christ and our community during church services, encourage people to be committed followers of Jesus. Help people to connect with God and fellowship with each other to grow in Christ.

Description

The duty of the Ushers Ministry is to make all feel welcome, to maintain good order in the service, and serve people. This involves, welcoming people as they enter the sanctuary, seating people, serving communion, distributing materials, and maintaining a tidy sanctuary.

Requirements:

- Attend ministry meetings when scheduled
- Agree with the Calvary Chapel Meridian Statement of Faith
- Seek the Lord in Bible study and prayer
- Attend a church service each week

Responsibilities:

- Be ready to provide direction to the restrooms, coffee bar, kid check-in area, etc.
- Be familiar with the information in the current bulletin, including upcoming events.
- Ushers should be in place 20 minutes prior to the services to which they are assigned.
- Open the door for those entering or leaving during periods when the door is closed (except during prayer).
- Distribute bulletins to those who raise their hand at the announcement person's direction.
- Distribute Bibles to those who raise their hand at the pastor's direction.
- Be polite and courteous at all times – model the grace of Jesus.
- Come ready to serve the people, not to be distracted by general fellowship with others (including servants).
- Notify security, your ministry leader, or a pastor if you observe something concerning.
