Responsibilities

1. **Schedule** – Work with worship teams to provide a forward looking plan for weekend and mid-week services, as well as small groups and special events.
2. **Disciple** – Build up the worship team(s) thru purposeful ministry such as; training, retreats, casual get-togethers, group meetings, prayer, and an emphasis on the important spiritual aspect of worship in a church setting. Create an inviting and gracious environment for newcomers to serve alongside that multiplies disciples.
3. **Audition** – Create purposeful opportunities to hear new servant singers and musicians.
4. **Outreach** – An eye towards evangelism to reach the community around us.
5. **Creative** – Sing a new song to the Lord with an approach to music selection that reaches our culture in a fresh way.
6. **Children** – Create an atmosphere teaching kids how to glorify the Lord through singing.
7. **Life Groups** – Provide leaders to enrich the church small groups.
8. **Teen/Youth** – Build up the church by reaching out to younger listeners.
