### Leader Responsibilities and Expectations

#### Mission

#### Qualities of a Leader

- Agree with the Calvary Chapel Meridian Mission and Statement of Faith.
- Seek the Lord daily in Bible devotion and prayer.
- Pass a criminal background check.
- Strive to be an example and model what it means to be a disciple of Jesus while encouraging those you serve to grow spiritually.
- Be outgoing, energetic and willing to **listen** to the teens encountered at and during events.

#### Role: Duties & Responsibilities

- Support the Youth Pastor in developing and implementing a team approach in all things.
- Help create a grace based and fun student discipleship environment.
- Adhere to youth ministry policies, procedures, and guidelines.
- Attend **at least one main church** service per week.
- Attend the Youth leadership meetings and training.
- Be familiar with the book of the Bible that is currently being taught to the students. Take the time to read the book and chapter being taught during Sunday mornings and at Thursday Night Youth Group.
- Help maintain order during all youth ministry functions. This will include correcting students who are causing a distraction.
- Help maintain a safe environment. Report or address any safety hazards or situations.
- Meet with the youth pastor monthly. His job is to help you grow and catch the vision of the ministry.
- Participate in youth group activities and events (fun days and camps/retreats)
- Build relationships with the students and parents to invest into their lives.
- Work within Youth Ministry policies to connect with students to disciple them in their spiritual walks and encourage them to be a witness for Christ daily within their network of peers.
- Make an effort to meet every student who comes to a Youth Group meeting or Sunday service.
