Teacher Expectations

- Seek the Lord daily in Bible devotion and prayer.
- Agree with the Calvary Chapel Meridian Mission and Statement of Faith.
- Agree with the Youth Group Leader responsibilities and expectation for Calvary Chapel Meridian.
- Be familiar with the book of the Bible that is currently being taught to the students. Take the time to read the book and chapter being taught during Sunday mornings and at Thursday Night Youth Group.
- Support the Youth Pastor in developing and implementing a team approach in all things.
- To come alongside the youth pastor and youth leaders in the support role.

Teacher Responsibilities

- Meet with the Youth Pastor once a month to discuss the ministry.
- Read assigned material given and meet to discuss it bi-weekly (every two weeks)
- Understand that the main teaching will be given by the Youth Pastor and that your role is to help him in leading the youth and youth leaders.
- Be willing to substitute when needed on Sunday and Thursday.
- Attend the Youth leadership meetings and training.
- Attend one main service whenever possible.
- It will require you to commit time to the ministry. Being a Youth Teacher is an extension of being a Youth Leader. You will still need to fulfill the duties of a Youth Leader when you are not teaching.
- At Calvary Chapel Meridian, we teach verse-by-verse through the Bible. It is our desire to teach the whole counsel of God's word. Whether teaching a section, chapter, or book, we do not skip any part of the Bible.
