



Playmakers In The Faith By Laws

Article I - Name The name of the organization shall be Playmakers In The Faith.

Article II - Mission The mission of Playmakers In The Faith is “to preach the Gospel worldwide and to teach all of the commands of our Lord Jesus Christ.” **Matthew 28:19-20**

Statement of Faith The following are the core beliefs of Playmakers In The Faith based on the foundational truths taught in the bible. All of our teaching and ministry is rooted in and flows out of these biblical doctrines.

GOD

We believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

We believe in Jesus Christ, God’s only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried; he descended to the dead. On the third day he rose again; he ascended into heaven, he is seated at the right hand of the Father, and he will come again to judge the living and the dead.

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. AMEN.

REVELATION

God has revealed Himself to us through his Son, Jesus Christ, who is the visible image of the invisible God, the holy scriptures, and through all of creation itself.

MANKIND

Humans, both male and female, were created in God's image for His glory. The first humans, Adam and Eve, were created without sin and appointed as caretakers of the rest of God's creations.

THE FALL

When Adam and Eve chose not to obey God, this caused them to fall out of fellowship with God, and fractured all of creation ever since that time.

SALVATION

Jesus Christ came to reconcile us with God. He lived a life without sin and willingly died on the cross to pay the penalty for our transgressions. God raised Him from the dead and now, by grace, offers as a free gift eternal life to all who follow Christ, by repentance, faith and obedience to their Lord and Savior. That is why salvation can only be found in Christ alone.

THE CHURCH

The Church is meant to be the visible body of Christ, sent into the world to glorify God and proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ.

RESURRECTION

Jesus Christ is returning one day to judge both the living and the dead and to usher in the fullness of God's kingdom on earth.

MARRIAGE

Marriage is between one man and one woman. A man shall leave his father and mother and shall cleave to his wife and they shall become one flesh. Marriage is until death do us part. (Genesis 2:24 - Matthew 19:3-12)

Article III - Qualifications of Board Directors As the purpose states, Playmakers In The Faith is targeted at reaching all nations at ages 14 and up. Board Directors must be faithful to our Lord Jesus Christ and have a desire to bring more souls into the Kingdom of God. Board Directors must live a life consistent with the Word of God. Directors must support the ministry's mission in prayer, giving, and serving.

All Board Directors will be encouraged to help support the ministry in sharing with family friends and colleagues.

***Board Directors** must believe in teaching ALL of the commands of our Lord Jesus. Board of Directors must believe in Playmakers In The Faith Core Beliefs. Directors cannot and will never submit to once saved always saved doctrine. Board Directors cannot and will never submit to oneness, Mormon, or Jehovah Witness doctrine. If a Board Director chooses to believe and submit to these doctrines, they must be removed immediately from their Board of Director position.

***Reasons why: Once Saved Always Saved** 1) Removes the Fear of the Lord. 2) It creates a haven for secret sin. 3) It removes the obligation for believers to obey the commands of Jesus. (Luke 17:7-10) 4) It creates a false comfort in the flesh.

Oneness Doctrine: 1) Does not honor the Son of God. 2) Denies the Son of God by not believing that He is seated at the right hand of the Father and that He existed with the Father before the foundations of the world.

Mormon & Jehovah Witness: 1) There are many heresies about their teachings on Jesus.

Article IV – Advisory Board Members and Selection Process

Section I: Advisory Board Members to be Selected Playmakers In The Faith shall have an Advisory Board Team that is comprised of up to Twelve people.

Section II: Qualifications of Advisory Board Members Each Board Member is encouraged to help the ministry by sharing, prayer, giving, and serving. Board Members must be faithful to our Lord Jesus Christ and His written Word. Board Members must agree with our Playmakers In The Faith Core Beliefs. Supporting the ministry in monthly or annual donations is important to help advance the goals of the ministry.

Board members are encouraged to help in the production of the Playmakers In The Faith television series. We are looking for Board Members with backgrounds in sports to help with ideas on how to better each episode in the television series.

Section III: Duties of the Board of Directors

The Board of Directors team will divide up responsibilities that follow and assume roles fitting of each representative's strengths:

- • Preside over all meetings
- • Work with the Playmakers Sponsor(s) in planning meetings, activities, programs/events, etc.

- • Give direction in setting group goals.
- • Demonstrate Christian leadership qualities. (Prayer, Give, Serve)
- • Inform members of all meeting times and locations (in advance).
- • Assist in program planning.
- • Take care of any physical needs of planned meetings/
- • Encourage Financial support from Board members and ministry members. .
- • Keep a record of each meeting. (Secretary can keep track)
- • Take care of written correspondence (to include thank you notes, correspondence with guest speakers, and more...)

Section IV: Selection of Leadership Team Representatives

Selection of the leadership team will be held two times a year to allow newly selected leadership team representatives to be trained by the existing Board of Directors.

Article V - Meetings Meeting frequency will be determined by the Board Chair Director. Regular meetings can be held weekly, bi-monthly, or monthly and will be conducted in an atmosphere where fellowship, growth, and outreach can be accomplished.

Article VI - Amendments Amendments to this constitution may be proposed by any Playmakers In The Faith Board Director. Amendments shall become effective if approved by two-thirds vote of the Board Directors and President.
