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All the lessons were interesting, but there are two I liked the most: "Choose Happiness and Choose Life" and "Love the Lord by Loving his Word."

This lesson "Choose Happiness and Choose Life" is based on Deuteronomy 28. This lesson really made me think if I live the way God would live or not, or if I find happiness in the right things. One of the points were: obey and you will be happy and blessed. When I think about obeying it doesn't seem hard, but it is when you try. In one of the sermons Andrey said that "It's either obedience or disobedience, there is no middle." This really made me think if I obey my parents. Or if I fall for things that look good and feel good. Sometimes I don't imagine my life without things I enjoy, I sometimes even think that it's impossible to live without them. But in Matthew 19:26 it says "With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible."

The next topic I want to talk about is the lesson "Love the Lord by Loving his word." Based on the text Deuteronomy 6:4-9. It explains how we have a choice to sin or not to. Most of us choose to! Sometimes I catch myself doing something I am not supposed to.

These topics have really influenced me to obey my parents. They also have taught me to use my time wisely, to find happiness in the right things. I have really tried to put God first in everything, before doing something I like. Try to not fall for things that look good and feel good. It had me question myself many different times. "If I live the way God would?", "If I find happiness in the right things?"
