

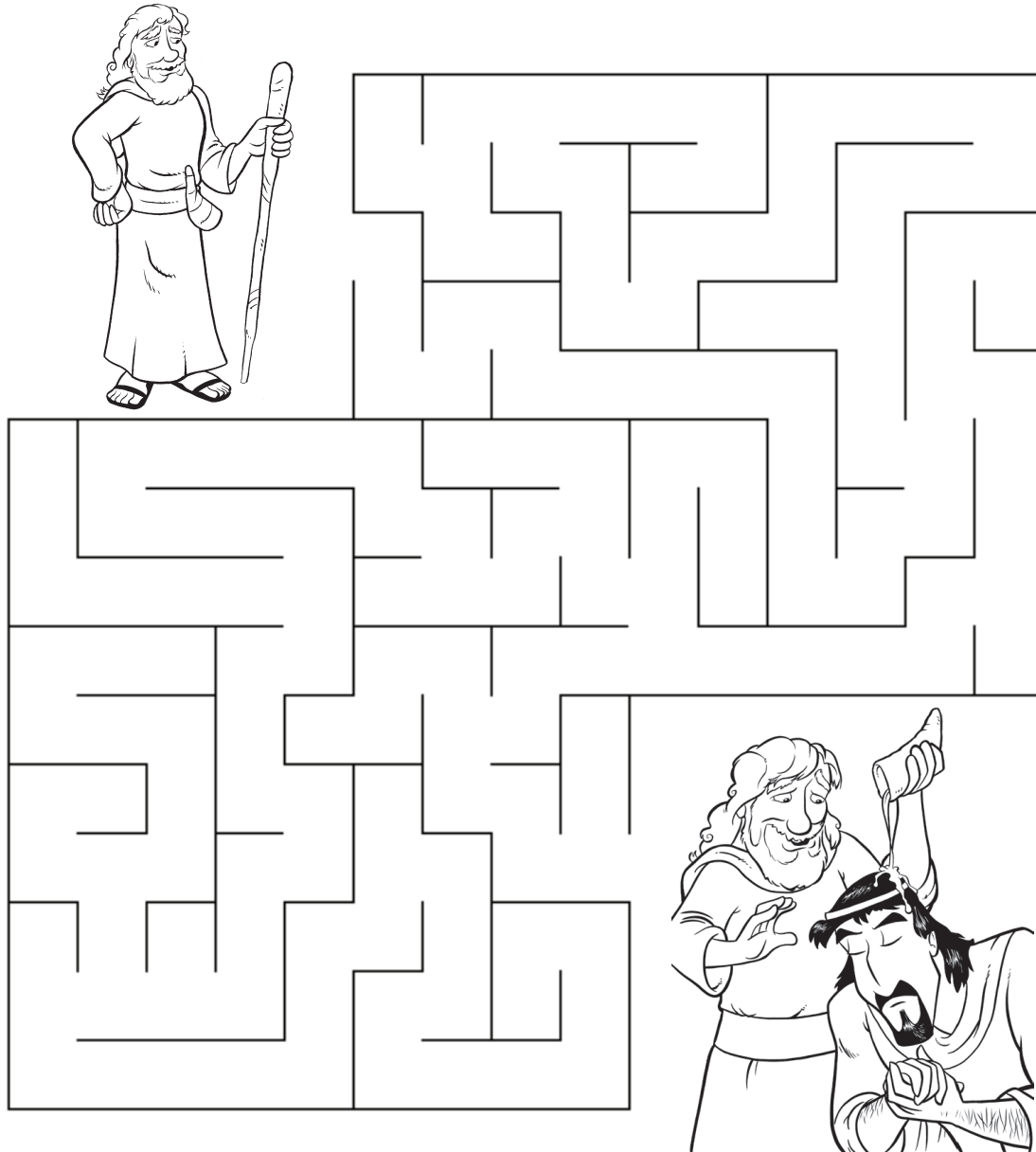


LESSON 15

Maze

God sent the Israelites into exile because of their sin. But God also promised to keep a remnant safe and restore them to the promised land. Help the Israelites to safely arrive in Babylon.



Even though Samuel was well-known throughout Israel (1 Sam 3:20), even though Saul lived just a few miles from Samuel's hometown, and even though Saul's servant knew who Samuel was (9:6), Saul did not know who Samuel was, nor did he think to seek God's word regarding his donkey problem. Israel would get the king they deserved, a tall and godless one, just like the nations around them because they rejected the LORD as their king.
