"Salvation belongs to our God,
who sits on the throne,
and to the Lamb."

The clear acknowledgment made in this passage of scripture is that people are different from each other. Some differences are fairly obvious, while some are less so. That's the acknowledgement.

But why wait for that day when we can have that today?! So, welcome, brothers and sisters of the Bouldercrest Church. May we together pursue the "one voice" Kingdom vision!
