Could you take a moment and pray for the people of Turkey and Syria affected by the recent earthquake? Here are 7 ways to pray for them.

Early Monday morning, February 6, 2023, a 7.8 magnitude earthquake struck southeastern Turkey and northwestern Syria. At the time of this writing, there are at least **11,600 dead** from the disaster. In addition, there are **tens of thousands injured** and many more homeless. We encourage you to take a moment and pray.

1. Pray for those who are injured and/or awaiting rescue.

There are thousands who are injured or trapped because of the earthquake. Pray that those who are injured would get the medical care they need and that those who are trapped under rubble would be found. Let's pray along with Psalm 147:3 that God would "heal the brokenhearted and bind up their wounds."
