Our community partners expressed their appreciation for the encouragement and interest in their organizations. His Way was the community partner for the month of October, and they showed up with many men enrolled in their program. His Way has provided hope and direction for those struggling with addictions. Marjorie and I had the privilege of attending the His Way fundraising banquet in September, with guest speaker Jeff Foxworthy. It was amazing! Special thanks to Al and Becky Bingham for their role as GC liaisons.

If you discovered any ministry that interested you, please reach out to them or contact me and I will help you get connected. Thanks for those who signed up for various ministries. The leaders of those ministries will be reaching out to you soon.

Our community partner for the month of November is **Cumming Elementary** (Dr. Jordan Livermore is the principal). GC has adopted three Elementary schools in our community: Cumming, Whitlow and Midway. These schools were chosen because they have a significant number of economically disadvantaged children enrolled. Cumming Elementary serves 887 students, with a 63% minority (mostly Hispanic) population. GC has provided turkey boxes and pantry foods to many of their families over the past two years. This year Dr. Livermore has requested **donations of coats** for their students, and would like to have GC members assist in handing them out. The giveaway will take place on November 17th from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. at Cumming Elementary. If you are available and would like to help, please let me know. We are looking for donations or new or gently used children's coats in all sizes. If you can shop for new coats, please contact me; we have funds available for use.
