21 Days of Fasting to 24 Days of Feasting?

For the last couple of years we have built good momentum through our December gatherings and into our 21 days of fasting campaign.

Then we get to February and things just kind of...stop.

It's not that we need to constantly be running fancy programs to keep people engaged, but it feels like we should have some way to harness all of that momentum. So this year we're going to try "24 days of Feasting and Feasting."

We'll begin on Sunday, February 4th, and encourage everyone connected to Grace Chapel to read one chapter of the gospel of Luke each day through the end of the month (that's 24 days). We'll focus on "feasting" on God's Word.

Additionally, as we have been forgoing food for much of January, we will encourage eating in February. When you think of a feast though, you don't only think of a lot of food, you think about a lot of people.

Once a week, get together with others to share a meal. Ideally, make time with your fellow feasters to read that day's chapter of Luke and discuss it as well.

There you have it, the first annual GC month of feasting and feasting!
