What are we doing for the lesson this month?

Instead of preaching, each week I'll be joined on stage with some other Grace Chapel members to discuss some selections from the gospel of Luke.

We are answering these three questions:

1. What stood out to you in the text?
2. What convicted you?
3. What is the least you can do about it?

The idea is not to foster a culture of laziness, but to be convicting and empowering. Convicting because even when we think, "What is the bare minimum I can do to obey Jesus?" we're often already doing more. Empowering because when you start thinking about the least you can do, your brain begins breaking down bigger commitments and commands into first steps and baby steps. Ideally, you will walk away from the text confident that you can do something, even if it's small.

Small steps, changes or actions can end up making big differences in our own lives and in the lives of those around us.

For the rest of February, don't just watch us talk about it; ask yourself, "What's the least I could do?"
