David Wheeler: Results from a recent MRI show that cancer in the right kidney is growing slowly, but there is a new, aggressive type of

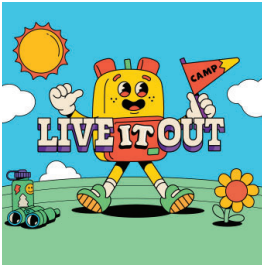

Bring your own dinner, or eat before you come. This is a great opportunity to invite friends!

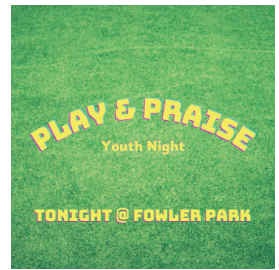


