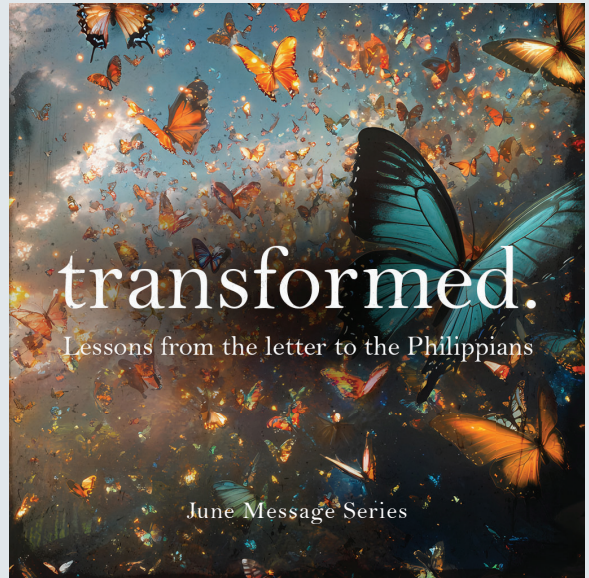

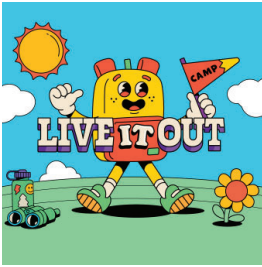

LIVE IT OUT: With Jesus we can help change the world.

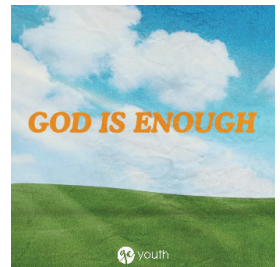


