(Psalm 24:1) The earth is the LORD's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it;

Stewardship - “the job of supervising or taking care of something, such as an organization or property.”

Good Stewards Understand:

- (1) The thing that you are stewarding is not yours. It belongs to someone else.

Good Stewards Understand:

(2) Stewards must hold
themselves accountable.

Good Stewards Understand:

(3) You cannot spend more resources than you have.

Good Stewards Understand:

(4) You must prioritize the things on which you will spend your resources.

What we say is most important does not reflect what is most important, but what we do reflects what is most important.

Good Stewards Understand:

(5) Spending (Using resources) is an investment. Investments bring returns.
