PART 1: RECAP. HAVE SOMEONE READ THIS OUT LOUD.

We focused on Genesis 1:1 this past week to help us understand the glory and power of God to create the world. This week we are reading more of Genesis 1 and into Genesis 2 to help us see more of the creation story. We find in our passage this week that we are created in God's image and how we should live our own lives in light of the creation story.

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PART 2: HAVE SOMEONE READ GENESIS 1:1-2:2 OUT LOUD. ANSWER THESE QUESTIONS AS A GROUP.

- Do you notice repeated words or phrases in this passage? What does this tell us about God from the order and design of creation?
 - How does this passage describe the relationship between people and creation?
 - What does it mean that humans are made in God's image? Where else in Scripture do you find this language?

PART 3: REFLECT. ANSWER THESE QUESTIONS TOGETHER.

- How does understanding God as Creator affect your daily life and trust in Him?
 - How can you recognize God's presence in your daily life? What should we be looking for each day?
 - What does this passage tell us about stewardship of God's creation? How should we care for God's creation?
 - Based on our passage, what should our worship and obedience to God look like? What needs to change for you to worship and obey God more fully?
