Clyde's Update

This is Holy Week on the church calendar. Churches all over the world will be focused on the journey of Jesus to go to Jerusalem and be arrested there which will take him to the cross. A cruel place where only the worst of the criminals would go. The innocent lamb of God taken there; joining two guilty ones whose lives were being taken away together. It is a sobering scene that would seem to be a kind of hopelessness that couldn't be overcome, but Sunday was coming. No one could have seen that coming. Jesus would walk out of that tomb and be seen by many. It was an event that would shape a whole new "religion". Christianity would be born from the message of this Jewish Messiah who was crucified, buried, and rose on the third day. When we do that service in our church, we highlight that moment when Jesus bowed down to his friends and began to wash their feet; a job set aside for a lowly servant, but he chose to do it to make a point to his friends in that room. Judas had already chosen to sell Jesus out for thirty pieces of silver and many of the others were asking about their position in this new kingdom Jesus was setting up in the coming days. We also bring the cross message into the service, as well, because that is what is ahead for the Son of Man. There is a kind of sadness to this story, and yet brings an image of love that can grip our hearts. It's why we do it every year so that we never forget. Join us.

Our "Seek" event on Saturday went very well. We finished the day putting into practice all the information we had learned throughout the day. I really enjoyed that part. It was a good day, and I can confidently say that what we learned will be put into practice in the coming year. Learning how to do a worship/prayer night is something I think we need to add to our list of things we do here. It was powerful and I have received lots of good feedback. As I mentioned on Sunday, I was so pleased with all the people who worked to make that event happen at a very high level. Our speaker was very pleased with the day and impressed with the way it all went. Heather did an entire day with the kids so parents could go, the nursery with Teresa and Larrisa kept the littles well cared for, Mary Burggraaf made sure we had plenty of food to keep up our energy, Liz put together the music (and there was lots of music), and we had a great group of folks who came to learn and to participate. Great job everyone!

What is Sunday's message? Well, it's Easter! The tomb is empty! Death has lost its sting! Jesus is alive! We'll talk more on Sunday. Have a great week!

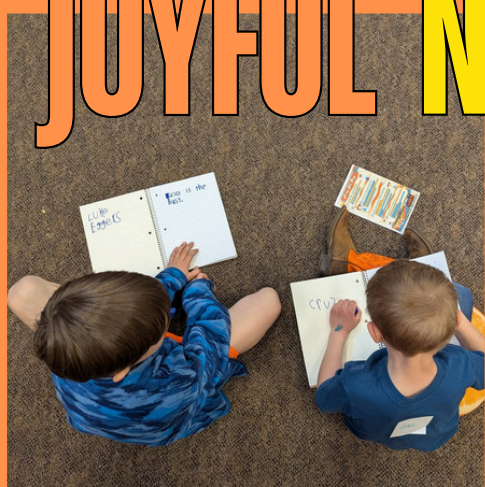
