HEATHER'S UPDATE KID'S MINISTRY

Hi Everyone!

As I said in my notes last week, registration is open for summer camp at Inspiration Hills. The Inspiration Hills theme of 2025 is Hebrews 13:8. www.inspirationhills.org. There are day camp and overnight camp options. Again this year, Community will fund half of the "early bird-before April 15" camp fee for kids who want to go to camp. When you go to sign up, there is an option to indicate the amount church will pay. For example: Discovery Camp is \$245. Community will cover \$122.50 of that cost. If paying for the remaining \$122.50 isn't possible for your family but you'd like to send them to camp, just send me an email and we can arrange a scholarship option. We want every child who would enjoy camp to have the opportunity to explore their faith in this new way. (Just don't pick the week of July 21 for camp, because that's our Vacation Bible School week! 😊)

I wanted to share some pictures from K-5 Midweek with you. The first photo is a project done by Logan V. He created Mary, Joseph, Jesus in the stable with a manger. Children learn and process their learning through play, so our Midweek time has been valuable for kids as they hear new and familiar Bible stories and interact with them in the way that works best in their brains. The second photo is of a classroom playing with hydrophobic sand. The sand can be put in water without getting wet! We were able to sculpt with it under water and when we scooped it out with the spoon, it was still dry! We talked about how God makes it possible for us to be in the world, but not of the world.
