Hi Everyone!

I don't usually write my newsletter on Wednesday nights after Midweek, but I had such a good night with the 4/5 grade class that I want to write a note before I forget. Our usual 4/5 grade teacher had to be gone this week, so I got to spend the evening with the crew. First, you just need to know how special the kids at Community are. We had some really good conversation, and their depth is far beyond their years. We talked about love and how we can love others because Jesus first loved us. We talked about loving others, even when it is hard, or someone seems harder to love. We talked about how God's love is different than friend love or "kissy kissy" love (their words- not mine. LOL!) But then....the questions started...and we had some big conversations about truth and doubt. They asked about Heaven and "that other place." They wanted to know if you can want to be with Jesus and think you know Jesus and love Him but still miss out on Heaven. They wanted to know what happens if you ask Jesus to forgive your sins and you trust in Jesus, but your mind tells you a lie and you accidentally believe the lie for a second, then you die.

These are really big questions that a lot of kids, youth, and grown-ups have. So, this is my little request to all of you to have a chat with the big kids in your world about Jesus. They need to know that Jesus WANTS them and LOVES them, even if they don't always do the right thing. Kids worry and they won't always share their worries with you because they are afraid "good kids" don't worry about that kind of thing. They know that sometimes kids die, and they think are afraid of missing out on eternity with Jesus. Kids want to be connected with Jesus, but just like grown-ups, sometimes the world makes it hard to feel like everything is ok. We had such a beautiful talk and we chatted with God about those worries for a long time. I've never heard them be so quiet and attentive/focused on one another and the topic at hand for so long. I encourage you to talk with the kids in your life about questions they might have about what it means to know Jesus. But you can't just dive in to a conversation like that without a little build up. 😊 They need to know it is safe and that you are paying attention. They need to know that you won't freak out if you don't know the answer to their question. They need to know you won't get distracted by a phone buzz. They need to know you won't laugh or tell someone what they asked. Please join me in asking God to help all of us at Community to be the safe people that kids need.
