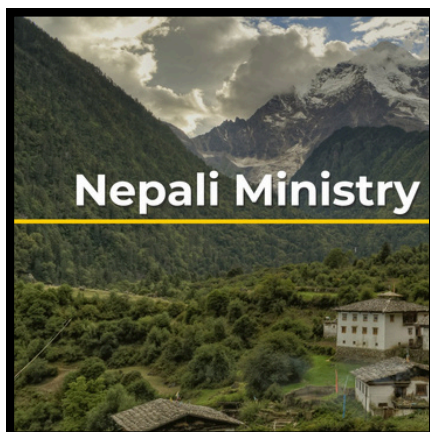

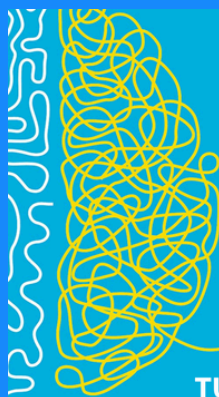
To our beloved church-
