KID'S MINISTRY

Summer is here! If you haven't yet, please register for VBS at: <https://communityrc.org/vbs>
Volunteer, bring friends, and pray for the awesome week ahead. We have the supplies, the activities, and the decorations. Now, we need you!!!

As Liz announced on Sunday, the Family Adventure packs are refreshed and ready for you to take home. We have a couple of new ones and the old favorites are still here. Everyone is invited to check the kits out. They aren't just for kids. Many of them have a puzzle inside and some have art supplies, so they are great for any family size- from one person to a larger bunch with a variety of ages. They are free to check out and don't have a set due date. Just bring it back when you are done having fun. The goal of these kits is to help people spend time with God and with one another.

Here's a run down of the available Adventure Packs:

- "Light"- New this year- A glowing soccer ball, Noah's Ark Operation game, some really interesting books, a telescope, a light up toddler toy, a glow in the dark puzzle, games including Space Launch and Bible Matching, light up tops, a light up activity board, flashlights, a glowing lawn game, a light up car track and more make this one a summer hit. There are activities for indoor and outdoor fun!
- "Stuck"- New this year- Noah's Ark travel game, Jonah Go Fish, Disc Bash lawn game, PopDarts (fun for big families or any size group), Atomix Puzzle Sphere, Clack Game, Fruit of the Spirit lawn toss, an animal puzzle, and the Aqua Mat make this set very fun. The books inside will help you notice many times when people felt stuck but God was not stuck at all!
- "Are we there yet?"- This pack is full of activities that can be done in the car or on a trip. Books, games, talk pack, music, and other activities will reduce the number of times you check the estimated arrival time by at least a few! The Bible is packed with stories about God asking people to go from one place to another and remind us that God is with us, even on an adventure.
- "Rainy Days are for Fun"- The Noah's Ark Adventure pack is ready for a rainy day (but also works for when it is too hot to be out for long.) This one has a 1000 piece Noah's Ark puzzle, a variety of games, and some cute toys for little kids too.
- "Lion Around"-Read the Bible stories that involve lions! Enjoy time relaxing in hammocks. Try some new board games and a really cool lion puzzle.
- "Trees"- Just as you'd expect, we meet Zacchaeus in this kit. Hang around in some hammocks, play Sneaky Snacky Squirrel game, test your knowledge with trivia cards, and more.
- "Lost and Found"- Learn how to do geocaching, play some seek and find games, look for bugs, and enjoy some fun books. Learn about lost sheep, prodigals, and coins.
- "Creation"- This one is full of indoor/ outdoor options including watercolor paints, nesting blocks, bug catching set for exploring God's amazing creation, and the game Headbandz.
- "Rocks"- use the rock painting set, games, slingshot copters, knock off toss yard game, dice games, disc golf set, and the fun game Slapzi to enjoy some good laughs and learning. I was amazed at how many Bible stories involve rocks!
- "A Snack and a Nap"- Everyone is in a better mood after a snack and a nap. The Bible has quite a few food related stories and we found fun activities to go with them. There are also 4 hammocks in this set so you can get your napping done in a fun place. With games like Throw Throw Burrito and Pancake Pile Up, you'll have plenty of fun! There are also binoculars for watching the birds and some fabulous books.
