
WD40

- Our church has a special partnership with the Frederique School in Haiti. In the past, teams from Community got to meet the kids on mission trips!


- Sponsoring a child is only \$200 per year until the child reaches Grade 7 (then it is \$325.)

- There are also optional opportunities for sponsors to purchase additional gifts. In the past some sponsors have chosen to buy Bibles or solar lanterns.




KIN ONE, TWO, AND THREE ARE SIMILAR TO PRESCHOOL/ KINDERGARTEN IN THE UNITED STATES.




FENELSON - GRADE 4








