AN EXAMPLE OF FALSE TEACHING (vs. 10-13)

Hebrews 13:10-13

- 1) **Salvation by Works / Earning God's Favor**
- 2) **Adding Requirements to the Gospel (Legalism)**
- 3) **Removing the Requirements of Holiness (Antinomianism)**

Modern Day False Teaching:

- 4) **Ritualism & Ceremony as Spiritual Power**
- 5) **Denying the Person and Work of Jesus**
- 6) **False Ideas About Angels, Visions, or Secret Knowledge**

Modern Day False Teaching:

- 7) **Prosperity Gospel / “Name It and Claim It”**
- 8) **Word-Faith Extremes / Speaking Reality into Existence**
- 9) **Hyper-Spiritual Warfare Obsessions**

Modern Day False Teaching:

- 10) “Jesus + Something Else” for Acceptance
- 11) Relativism (“Truth is Whatever You Feel”)
- 12) “Food Laws Make You Holy”
