Today's Lesson

Realizing he too had been forgiven by God, Wee decided to forgive Lee and expressed that he held no bad feelings. Lee apologized, admitting he hadn't considered Wee's feelings. This experience reminded Wee that love and forgiveness flow from God and should be shared with others. make Wee feel. I guess Love and forgiveness is just like a river that get's it's water from a source (like we receive love from God) and then it flows out to others. We love others because God loved us first.
