Wake Up, World!

It wasn't even Christmas (it was early March), but she acted as if it were. My wife's excitement opening a box was equal to any child's on Christmas morning. What could have her so giddy? Catch this—a brand-new alarm clock. (LOL! How many holidays did I waste with jewelry?) Alarm clock? What's the big deal? Well, this wasn't your average alarm clock. It came with a "sun up light" feature. Twenty minutes before the alarm was supposed to sound, a yellowish, sun-like light, would begin softly and grow brighter and brighter, illuminating the room. It sounds silly, but her excitement was real. However, excitement turned to frustration. Setting it to actually work tested my patience. The directions were written in simple English, but the clock wouldn't submit to my simple commands. We lost days testing it. Each morning, she'd announce, with great disappointment, "It didn't work." I re-read the instructions and then re-read them again. And then, almost as if it had a mind of its own, it started working. It was luck mostly. Now, before the ear-piercing alarm startles us to alertness, we get the enjoyment of a soft morning sunrise, begging us to awaken (truth is . . . we sleep through that too!).

Easter is a yearly trumpet blast for people to receive a wake-up call. All of mankind is asked again to wake up to the reality of God, wake up to the fact that Jesus did raise from the grave, wake up to the truth there really is a heaven. Or, we can hit the snooze bar and put it all off, hoping for more time and another year, gambling with our eternity.

God is issuing yet another wake-up call. Is there a chance you're asleep? The wake-up call is still soft and gentle, begging for our attention. But one day, when the second coming of Jesus starts, it will come with a loud and clear trumpet blast. It will be too late then to accept Jesus' forgiveness. It will be too late to pray, too late to repent, too late to change course. Your eternity will be set. This could be our last Easter together. I'm not saying it is. 



HeartSong Home Concert is April 6 at 4:00 pm!

HeartSong, our jr. high choir, will be on our annual ministry tour April 4-6, 2025!

Under the direction of Lisa Ramlow, the 2025 message of HeartSong is entitled "Don't Stop Prayin'!" Through a collection of worship songs, brief drama sketches, and scripture, HeartSong's message is relevant for all ages that will encourage and uplift you. The songs are great arrangements of contemporary songs, hymns, and classics like *The Prayer* from such recording artists as Patrick Mayberry and Matthew West.

HeartSong consists of 26 students – 5th thru 8th grades, which includes Choir, T.R.A.S.H., (a percussion ensemble which creates unique and amazing rhythms using found objects made of plastic and metal sort of like STOMP), and Drama Team. With sponsors, the total group will be 36.

We will be on tour to Litchfield, visiting the St. Louis Zoo, as well as singing two concerts at assisted living facilities in Litchfield, and at the 10:00 am service Sunday morning at Christian Church of Litchfield, before heading back to LCC for our home concert at 4:00 pm! GLOBAL IMPACT

Kuki Christian Church Mission Manipur, India

Nearly two years have passed since the horrific attack on Christians in Imphal, Manipur, India, which saw Christians murdered, churches and homes burned, and the loss of the Christian Hospital and KCCM Seminary. Please continue to pray for our brothers and sisters. Sometimes we talk about and pray for the persecuted church without being able to put names and faces to our prayers. These dear brothers and sisters whom we know and love are the persecuted church in India. By the grace and blessing of God, they continue educating and ministering.



In September 2024, KCCM laid the foundation stone for a new hospital approximately 18 miles north of their former site in Imphal and construction began. Their nursing students continue to score very well on their annual exams despite all of the upheaval. The ministry outreach of KCCM continues as well. They report many baptisms among the Gorkha, the church on Majuli Island, Tripura, and a new church in Nepal. The Kuki Christian Church continues to reach out in support of thousands of people displaced by sectarian violence. Relief materials include rice, potatoes, water, edible oils, clothing, and other essential items. Additional relief materials include Bibles and hymnals. These materials, provided by KCC and others, are distributed through Motbung Relief Camp, Ngahmun Relief Center Kangpokpi, Mandop Camp, Saibol Camp, Govajang Relief Center, Monglham Relief Center, and others.

Political unrest continues in Manipur. The state government has collapsed and President's Rule was imposed on the state on February 13, 2025. There have been protests among the people. Please pray for these dear Christians. We hope to host Alet and Kimcha this fall.

Other special outings have included a visit to the Lincoln Museum here in Lincoln, as well as the museum at The Mill. Another fun outing was thrifting in Clinton and lunch at Monical's Pizza. All widows are welcome to join any of our meetings!
