Leaving FOOTPRINTS Others Can Follow

In New Mexico, they have discovered prehistoric human footprints. Other discoveries have shown fossilized human tracks close to or in connection with dinosaur prints. Curious! According to some, these may shed light on the coexistence of men and dinosaurs. But deniers claim these are the result of erosional distortions, natural irregularities in the rock or perhaps the impressions left by dinosaurs that appear human. Regardless, these are some of the oldest footprints in existence and everyone is talking about them.

Other footprints can get a lot of press too. The mythical Big Foot leaves footprints that are popular. Hollywood's Walk of Fame in front of the Chinese Theater gets a lot of attention. One of my all-time favorite footprints is the iconic photo of the first lunar step on the moon by Neil Armstrong. "That's one small step for man. One giant leap for mankind."

When a child is born you discover that, "There is no foot too small to leave an imprint on the world." Or perhaps more sentimentally, "The first steps your baby takes are into your heart."

Sometimes hiking the mountains we encounter snow. That feels odd to us from low-land Lincoln to see snow in July but in the higher backcountry it's normal. Walking over snow, to avoid post holing, we'd follow in the steps of the one who first walked across on top. We followed in his steps.


We do the same following Jesus. I Peter 2:21 says, "To this you were called, because Christ suffered for you, leaving you an example, that you should follow in his steps."

Wherever we go, whatever we say, and whatever we do, we are leaving marks behind us. Some of these marks will be remembered for years to come. Leaving footprints others can follow is important.

Jesus did that for us. We do that for others. This is something most of us want to take seriously. What footprints will we leave in this life? Will our steps encourage others to want to follow Christ too? I hope so!





Thank you! Thank you! Thank you! For those of you who do not know us, **Christian Child Care, INC** is one of your Local Impact Missions. We have been a licensed childcare provider since 1989 for your community. We were founded through a vision from five local Christian organization's leadership which deemed quality childcare a high need in Logan County. These founding organizations were Lincoln Christian Church, Lincoln Christian College and Seminary, which later became Lincoln Christian University, Christian Homes, Inc., The Christian Village, and Jefferson Street Christian Church.

Since 1989, CCC has grown from 19 children on opening day to our present enrollment of 102 children. We currently serve 16 infants, 10 toddlers, 13 two-year-olds, 14 three-year-olds, 18 four-year-olds and 25 school-aged kids! We provide Christ-centered, quality care for children from ages six weeks through twelve years old year-round. Our program is nationally accredited through the National Accreditation Commission and we have earned recognition of the highest level of quality childcare as a Gold Circle of Quality designee through the Illinois ExceleRate program. What does all that mean? It means children are supported in the best possible environments, taught by educated teachers who chose children as their passion, and parents are supported so they can work and meet the needs of their families.

LCC, you help make this happen. These achievements could not have been possible without the generous support of your Local Impact Ministry back in 1989 and still today. Your support is so very important to the children we serve. You are helping your community thrive!

GLOBAL IMPACT

Kuki Christian Church Mission, Manipur, India

It has been almost one year since our Kuki brothers and sisters were viciously attacked in their homes and churches in Imphal, Manipur, India. They had to abandon what was left of their possessions, churches, and all buildings of the Kuki Christian Church Mission in Imphal. They had to leave the hospital with all equipment, the seminary, everything. The children in the orphanage had to be placed with extended family. Many of our people were living in an army camp in terrible conditions. There is still much suffering. In spite of all of the awful things that happened, and their own personal loss, KCCM knew their ministry must continue. They relocated to a smaller, more rural region north of Imphal and have kept the theological school and the nursing school going in very cramped and meager facilities. They have rebounded with the help of Christians in India and the US and are in the process of trying to rebuild. Please continue to pray for our persecuted family in India. If you are interested in helping monetarily, please contact the church office for more information. If you are supporting an orphan, please continue giving; the money is going to the extended family for the ongoing care of the child.



Please also be in prayer for **Caitlin Gowin** who has a summer internship in Ethiopia with CMF (Christian Mission Fellowship-BJ & Mary Leonard are also with CMF) and for **Julia Guzzardo** who has a summer internship in a middle eastern country working in

a community center. Pray that they are able to raise the funds needed, and pray for the individuals they will meet and minister to--that hearts and minds will be receptive to Christ's message. Pray for both of them as they finish their semesters well!


