
- ❖ Mile Marker 1 is a time of discovery.







B. J. & Mary Leonard, Missionaries to Kenya

We treasure the delightful Leonard family



as one of our own (B. J. launched LCC's previous Quest youth program), with over 20 years of ministry experience, who have a big heart for the unreached, and are another example of a long line of Lincoln Christian University alumni working around the world to help grow disciples for the kingdom.

Please stop by the Missions Wall in the Family Room at church to see their photo and pick up a prayer bookmark. Your Global Impact Team invites you to think about creative ways you can pray for and encourage the dedicated missionaries of Lincoln Christian Church. And also get to know who they are, take an interest in their work, and host them as family when they are stateside. You and your prayers can make a real difference for missions. B. J. and Mary are serving on Christian Missionary Fellowship's Kenya Church Catalyst team. They support disciple-making and church planting through training, discipling, and coaching as they dream to take the message of Christ to every city and village in Kenya, Africa! They have met with and encouraged several Massai pastors, discussed ideas with women for projects to help them support their families, helped prepare Disciple Making Movement training for youth, and had the honor to baptize new believers! They have been attending language and culture classes to increase their understanding and use of Kiswahili while homeschooling their children; the kids are excited to start at West Nairobi School and the Kizora Center in August. They have applied for resident permits and driver's licenses.

Along with others in East Africa, they have endured significant flooding with challenging travel, but they feel they've adjusted well since arriving in Kenya last fall and have recently been able to move into their own rental home. In the midst of moving, they learned of B. J.'s dad, Mark's cancer and made an emergency trip to the U.S. in June. (Note: We just learned of Mark's passing in mid-July, so pray for B. J. and Mary as they return to be with family during this

difficult time.) Thank you for joining your Global Impact Team in prayer for the Leonard family and their ministry as they serve the Lord with passion! They are grateful for your financial support (\$200/month from our church) and partnership in building God's Kingdom in Kenya. We look forward to sharing a personal communion meditation/offering video from B. J. soon.

His Hands Outreach, Inc.

If you drive by our building on North Adams Street, you will see a change in our sign in the front of the building. Instead of *Hope Grows Neighborhood Center*, we are now *Hope Grows Bible School for Kids*.

We continue to build relationships with kids and families in the neighborhood by sharing the gospel at every opportunity. But we are now trying to intentionally disciple our core group of kids and immerse them in the Bible. Each kid has their own Bible, and we are memorizing Scripture. We're doing sword drills to teach them to be familiar with the Bible and where to find the Scripture they need.

During our Sunday Church Service, the kids follow along in their Bibles and participate in reading the Scripture. Many of these kids are now reading the Bible at home on their own! Along with Sunday Service, we also have Monday Memorization, Tuesday Teaching (the kids prepare and teach a lesson), and Wednesday Worship. In the past month, we have baptized seven Junior High and High School kids, a mom and a stepdad! We are also doing many fun activities so please continue to pray for us. God is working!
