Do You Love Me?

"I love you more!" is a little game my granddaughter likes to play. She starts with "I love you, Papa." I respond with "I love you more." Then we argue with each other over and over as to who loves who the most. Somehow I never tire of the game.

Love is an important aspect of the Christian life. Imperative actually! We're told to love God with all our hearts, soul, mind, and strength. Told to love others as we love ourselves. Told to love one another. Told to love our neighbor. Told to love our enemies. And if we're not careful, we can lose our first love...Jesus.

Jesus will ask Peter, "Do you love me?" Peter didn't hesitate to answer yes. But Jesus will ask two more times. What's the point of that? I think Jesus is asking again. This time he's asking us.

Oh, don't be so quick to answer yes. Think about it for a moment. Do we REALLY love Jesus? Not just the idea of Jesus. Not just the stories of Jesus. Not just the benefits of heaven. I mean Him. Do I love Jesus? This is important!

Here's a connection I've discovered about loving Jesus. Once I get that right in my life, it feeds my love in other areas. Can that be true? Oh yes!

I couldn't love church till I learned to love Him. I couldn't love others till I learned to love Him. I certainly can't love my enemies until I get this love for Him right first. This was the main problem with the church at Ephesus, they had lost their first love. And that in turn affected the entire church and ministry.

I wonder if this isn't affecting us too. Our biggest issue is this right here...loving Jesus. When I get this right, it will change everything. Just like the fire that Peter sat by when Jesus asked, "Do you love me?" Peter's love was relit and it changed everything for him. I believe God wants to relight that fire in us too.

Starting in September, our sermon series is about just this. Do I love Jesus and if so, what will that do for me? What will that do for our family? Since September is also our fall kick-off, this would

be a good series to invite others to join us.

Come, as we explore, "Do I really love Jesus?"

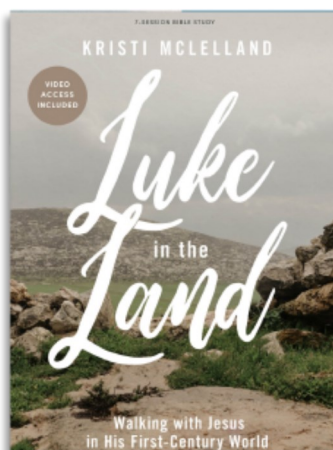
Next Steps Experience

GLOBAL IMPACT

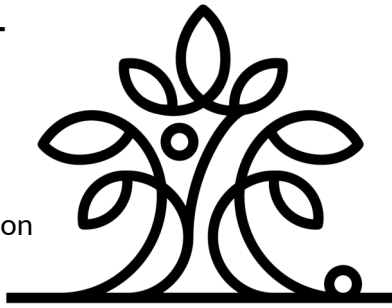
Orchard Group

In 2002, I went to New England, Vermont specifically, to work with Restoration House Ministries.

I was in 7th grade, and the experience had a great effect on my life. New England is one of the least Christian areas in our country. Yet, God has not given up on this region. God has called people to plant churches in places like Vermont, New Hampshire, and Maine so that people can know the Gospel. Restoration House is now part of Orchard Group, but the mission is the same today as it was in 2002 when I visited. Tanner Green is in charge of New England Church Planting at Orchard Group, and he shares that God is at work. Three new churches have been planted in the last three years!

Beacon Church, in New Hampshire, is growing and becoming sustainable. In fact, they are moving into their first building this fall. City Coast Church, in Connecticut, just baptized six people in August! God is at work! But the work isn't finished. Please pray that God would call more church planters to New England. Tanner told me that it is hard to find planters. They are looking for quality leaders to answer God's call. Please also pray for Tanner and his family as they build roots in their new city of Boston. Personally, it is cool to see God continue the work I saw when I was in 7th grade. I hope to go back someday soon to see that work continue. Please join me in prayer for New England.

LOCAL IMPACT

Lincoln/Logan Food Pantry

The pantry opened in June of 1993 when several churches and smaller pantries joined together to offer one larger, more efficient pantry. It began in the basement of the First United Methodist Church in Lincoln, IL. In order to keep up with the growing demand in the Lincoln/Logan area, it moved to its current location at 125 N. Logan St. in Lincoln. The new building was furnished by the First United Methodist Church free of charge. Over the years they have added a walk-in freezer, an addition to the west and a waiting room through the help of local foundation and corporate donations.

The pantry serves many individuals in Lincoln and Logan County each month. Here's a recent report to help illustrate the scope of the ministry:

- Children served	377	396
- Households served	360	360
