This is the story of God. From cover to cover you will find:

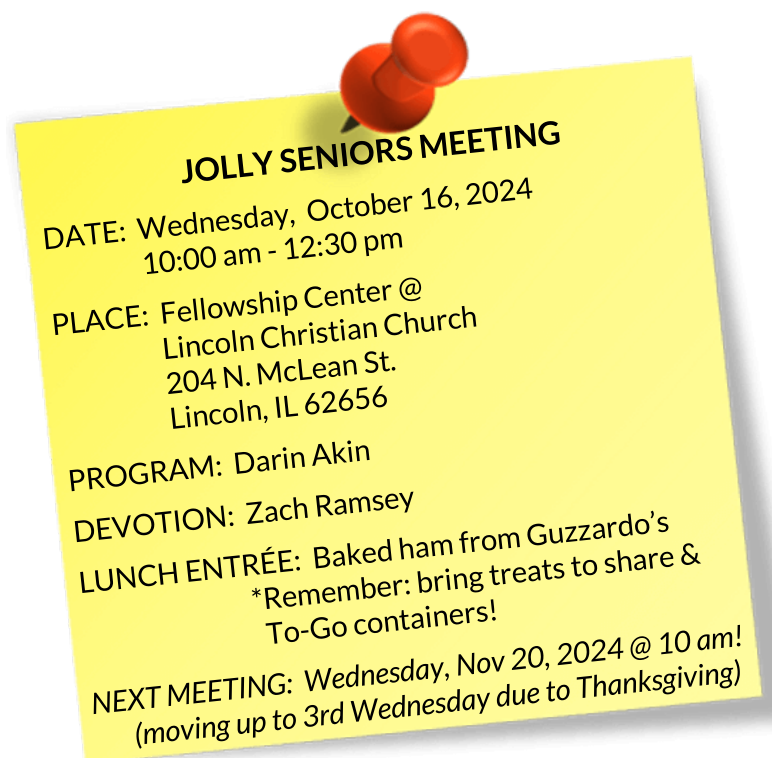
One Hero — the Messiah

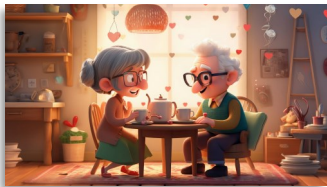

Asia Pacific International—Indonesia

What a privilege it is to be able to support God's work in Indonesia! Mentoring 186 churches and 103 church planters, API continues to disciple believers through their prison ministry, community programming (Smart Point), church planting, health clinics, and ministry training school. There are over 195 million Indonesians who have never had the opportunity to hear about Jesus. Our brothers and sisters in Christ are determined to change that number through the strength, provision and grace of God. Prayer was a focus of their last weekly email. If you are accepting Ron's challenge to amp up your prayer life—here's some prayer fuel:

Praise God for Vision Land, a sustainable agricultural program, that is a part of Smart Point. **Praise God** for the new preaching posts that have been established on several islands. **Pray** for the children of church planters. **Pray** for leadership training in local churches. **Pray** for the Smart Point teachers who serve in remote areas. Being a Christian is a challenge in this Muslim majority country. Please pray for our brothers and sisters.

- We had 1,883 youth campers through our 10 weeks of summer camp!
