



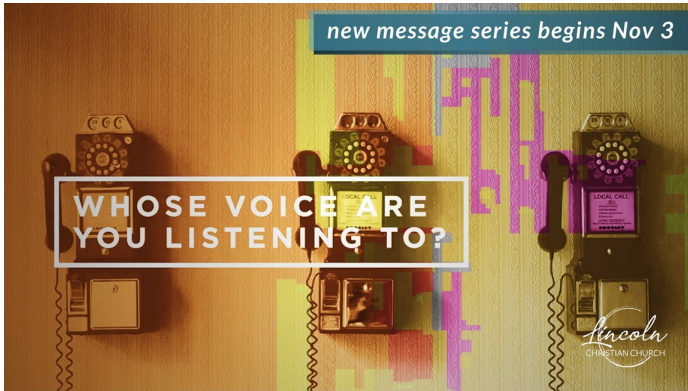

Whose Voice Do You Listen To?

In Mark 5, a synagogue leader approached Jesus with this tender plea, "My daughter is dying. Please come and heal her?" Jesus agreed to go with him and started for the man's house.

As they walked together, a servant from Jairus' household came and said, "Your daughter has died. Why bother the teacher anymore?" Jesus heard what was said and responded, "Don't be afraid . . . just believe." At this point, Jairus had two voices in his ear. Which one would he listen to?

When Jairus and Jesus reached his home, there was a crowd already mourning there. Jesus asked them why they were crying because the girl was not dead. The crowd laughed at Jesus. Again, Jairus had a choir of unbelieving voices in his head. Would he listen to them or to Jesus?

Jesus entered the room where the girl was laid, raised her back to life, and gave her back to her parents. How thrilled was Jairus that he listened to Jesus and not all those other voices?

There are many voices that would lead us astray; make us feel uncertain, afraid, devalued, hopeless, unloved, unattractive, unimportant, and unworthy. We don't have to listen to them. There is another option.

There are some people who go from person to person, preacher after preacher, they buy books, listen to podcasts, looking for someone who will say what they want to hear. If you search long enough you'll ALWAYS find someone who is willing to agree with you. Is that really what we need?

Every day we have a choice to make as to who we will listen to. We can listen to culture: "You have to be true to you . . . follow your heart . . . do what feels good!" We can listen to the devil: "You're worthless, you're cursed, you will never amount to anything."

Or we can listen to God: "You are my treasure . . . my prized possession . . . I love you . . . I have a plan for you!"

This November, we will be in a short series looking at the right and wrong voices of our time.

Jesus once said, "My sheep hear my voice, and they follow me." Are we tuned into the one voice that really matters? We'll talk about that voice in this series: *Whose voice are you listening to?*

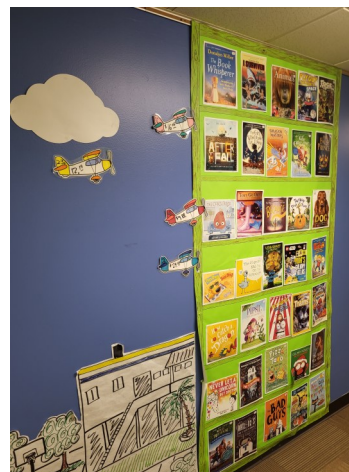

GLOBAL IMPACT

The Wall for the Unreached from Team Expansion really blessed our church this past month. It is heavy to see how many

people groups there are in the world who do not know Jesus. Thankfully, our church supports multiple missionaries who try to reach these unreached people.

One of those missions is Kerala Christian Mission in the state of Kerala, India. According to Joshua Project, there are 361 unreached people groups in Kerala. Many of these people groups are Hindu and Muslim. The mission is doing good work reaching people for Jesus! This past summer the partner churches had VBS and saw 4,500 kids attend. 500 of those were from other religions. People in the surrounding towns are curious about Jesus and want to know more! Praise God! The churches are raising up young leaders for the future of the churches. God is doing amazing things in India. The Gospel of Jesus is spreading.

However, there are still major obstacles to the spread of Christianity. In many rural areas, Hindu Zealots are strong and committing crimes against Christians. Thankfully, the authorities are starting to protect the people. Elections matter, as we know in the States. In India, there is a political group called the BJP. Prime Minister Modi is the leader of this group. Overall this party has done a lot of good to develop the country. However, some members of this political party want to make India a Hindu nation and turn a blind eye to religious persecution, like the horrible persecution of our other Indian missionaries, the Kuki Christians. But after the new election, there was more debate in parliament and other groups are pushing for protections against such violence.

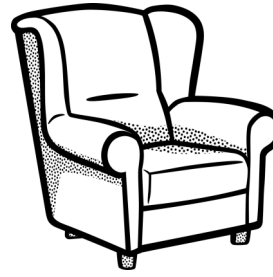
