Stories That Changed Our Lives

I was a young father telling bedtime stories to twin sons who had grown tired of the nursery rhymes and the Three Bears and Goldilocks. "We're too old for that, Dad," was their complaint. They wanted something new—a story with more adventure. They wanted me to make something up. Struggling to come up with one on the spot, I began weaving together a fresh tale of a young star trooper named Luke Skywalker and his epic fight against his nemesis, Darth Vader. (I know, I know, it was not an original story, but they didn't know that.) They were captivated. They were so transfixed by the story they couldn't sleep. Night after night they begged for more. Lying in bed between them, along with added sound effects, I continued retelling the movie plot as if it were my own. One evening, my son Matthew said, "Dad, you're the best storyteller ever!" He was right, even though I cheated somewhat.

A good story captures our attention and draws us in. That's probably why Jesus told so many stories. He was a master storyteller, using common subjects and everyday experiences to share deep truths about God, His kingdom, and us.

When Jesus spoke, people listened. Hundreds, even thousands gathered to hear what He had to say. His stories met people where they were with such a deep impact. His stories were not forgotten. He shared deep truths about the Kingdom of Heaven and did it through everyday ideas. Most people saw themselves in the stories. Some discovered even deeper truths about God and his love for us. And some hated his stories because they hit too close to home.

Our February sermon series is entitled, "Stories that Changed Our Lives." We're going to walk through some of the most iconic parables ever told and why we love them so much. In each, there is the obvious lesson—the one every preacher has told. However, deeper, underneath the obvious, is a secret truth still waiting to be discovered. How? Because of what these stories will do to us.

In these parables, we'll take a closer look at what these stories mean and how they impact us today—in the story that we're living.

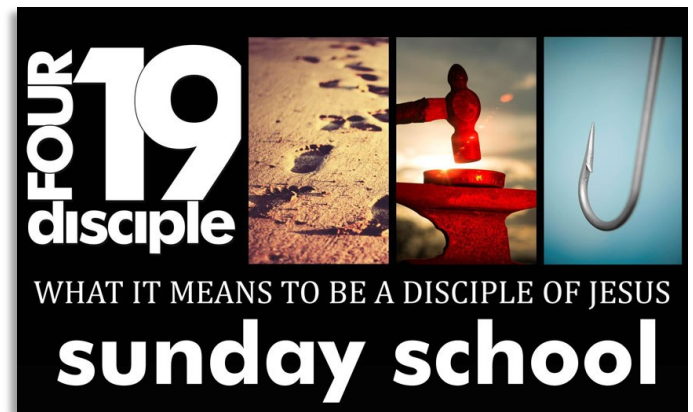

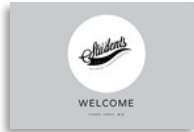

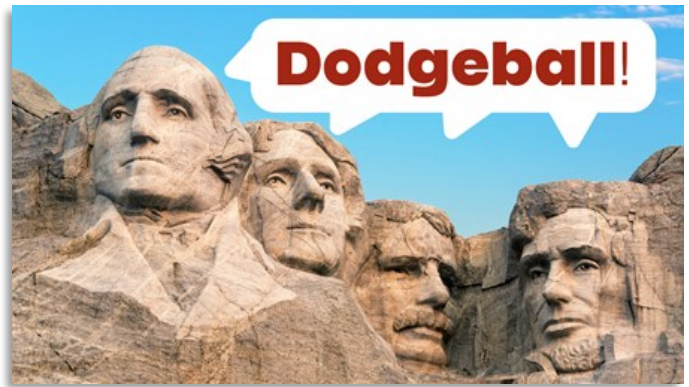


Scholarships for Move

GLOBAL IMPACT

Johnny and Janelle have been serving in Thailand for almost two years and are working closely with the Prosperous Youth Foundation. The organization works with children who are in institutional care in the Chang Mai area. While they offer training and opportunities for discipleship all year, their biggest event is Youth Camp which Johnny, Janelle, and their family participated in this year.



The youth camp provided 329 children with the chance to have fun and learn about the Bible. This year's camp was an incredible success with 30 students committing their lives to Christ and 47 expressing an interest in working in ministry. Janelle served on a committee that created a prayer room for the campers. Since many of these children have dealt with tragedy and loss, the prayer room became a safe space for students to share their feelings and learn how to take them to the Lord in prayer. Johnny has been teaching English to some of the children as a way to build relationships and to improve his Thai, while also gaining a better understanding of what life is like at the children's homes so they can better serve the needs of both the children and staff.

Please continue to pray for Johnny, Janelle, and their family as they continue their work in Thailand. The Chang Mai area has recently dealt with massive flooding, and although their family was not directly affected, they did know many who were. Their former country continues to be an area full of injustice and conflict, so they ask that we pray for peace and justice for that country as they are still connected to many in the area. They have also asked that we pray for their own ongoing efforts in learning the Thai language and for their children who have recently been baptized!
