

FOM TEAM PROPHETIC PROTOCOL

- **ALWAYS PROPHECY IN LOVE**

1 Cor 14:3 (NASB) 3 But one who prophesies speaks to men for edification and exhortation and consolation.

Love the people you are ministering too. Love should be the motivation behind prophecy. Do not prophecy out of bitterness, anger or hurt.

Love seeks to edify, love is not rude, harsh, or condemning. Be polite!!!

Make sure your heart is right before serving.

- **OPEN YOUR EAR TO HEAR FROM GOD.**

Expect to hear from God, cultivate a discerning spirit

John 10:27 (NASB) 27 My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me;

You can pray a few minutes in tongues (but you release in English) it is ok to wait to hear

- **NO LONE RANGER PROPHETS!!!**

Work together on the team, yielding to the word of the Lord being released one at a time

- **ALL PROPHECY SHOULD BE RECORDED**

Give to the person to be judged, meditated on and to war over, people should get a copy to take home

1 Corinthians 14:29 (NASB)

29 Let two or three prophets speak, and let the others pass judgment

- **DON'T ADD OR TAKE AWAY**

Say what you hear or see the Lord is saying

nothing more, nothing less

- **FACIAL EXPRESSIONS**

Be aware of facial expressions and gestures, avoid the dramatics.

ex: Don't have a sour face when your ministry team partner is giving a prophecy. Don't seem disinterested. Keep a straight face or smile and stay engaged until the end. Be courteous.

- **NO SHOWBOATING**

Be humble. Holy Spirit exalts Jesus and the testimony of Jesus is the Spirit of prophecy.

Revelation 19:10 (NASB) Then I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "Do not do that; I am a fellow servant of yours and your brethren who hold the testimony of Jesus; worship God. For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."

- **DON'T COMPARE**

Don't compare your flow to anyone else's, avoid competition.

2 Corinthians 10:12 (NASB) For we are not bold to class or compare ourselves with some of those who commend themselves; but when they measure themselves by themselves and compare themselves with themselves, they are without understanding

- **BAD RESPONSES/CONFLICTS**

If you get a bad response from someone, remain calm and peaceable, handle the situation with love and wisdom. Report conflicts to an overseer.

- **CONNECT YOURSELF TO PROPHETIC ACCURACY**

Submitting to others avoids pride. Don't prophecy under pressure, you will miss the voice of the Lord. Be honest if you miss the mark as this will help you develop your gift.

- **PROPHECY ACCORDING TO THE PORTION OF YOUR FAITH**

Understand your strength and weaknesses, be an original not a copycat or you will lose your authenticity.

Romans 12:6 (NASB)

Since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, each of us is to exercise them accordingly: if prophecy, according to the proportion of his faith;

Ephesians 4:7 (NASB)

But to each one of us grace was given according to the measure of Christ's gift

- **WHEN MINISTERING TO THE OPPOSITE SEX**

Do not lay hands on any area of the person that may be sensitive.

Be gentle in laying of hands on head or shoulders.

- **DON'T ALLOW PEOPLE TO WORSHIP THE GIFTS**
Stay humble!! Always give God all the Glory as He does not share
Isaiah 42:8 (NASB) "I am the Lord, that is My name; I will not give My glory to another, Nor My praise to graven images."
- **KEEP THE PROPHECY LINED UP**
Keep the prophecy lined up with the Word of God. Make certain the enemy doesn't lead you off course.
Matthew 24:35 (NASB) 35 Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will not pass away
- **STUDY TO SHOW YOURSELF APPROVED**
Don't release anything contrary to scripture.
2 Timothy 2:15 (NASB) Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the word of truth.
- **KEEP RULE OVER YOUR OWN SPIRIT**
Don't allow things to get out of control
1 Corinthians 14:32 (NASB) and the spirits of prophets are subject to prophets;
Proverbs 25:28 (NASB) Like a city that is broken into and without walls Is a man who has no control over his spirit.
- **DON'T BE REPETITIOUS**
Don't be repetitious to make a prophecy longer. Stop when Holy Spirit is done.
Luke 12:12 (NASB) for the Holy Spirit will teach you in that very hour what you ought to say.
- **KEEP THE TEAMS TO 2 OR 3 PEOPLE**
Keep unity in the Spirit and the bond of Peace and Love.
Ephesians 4 1-3 (NASB) Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called, 2 with all humility and gentleness, with patience, showing tolerance for one another in love, 3 being diligent to preserve the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
- **ALWAYS CLOSE THE PRAYER**
Always close the prayer/prophetic time covering them with the Blood of Jesus Sealing the words of Jesus in their heart.
