Good Things to Know

Things to Know About Registration

- 1) Students going into 6th graders may choose to attend either Junior Camp or Senior Camp.
- 2) There needs to be 1-adult for every 8 students (male & female)
- 3) Please send Refuge Ministries an estimated number of campers by May 15, 2024
- 4) When you arrive at camp come to the Gym first to finish registration and to receive your cabin assignments.
- 5) There will be a snack shop available during camp. We suggest if your campers bring cash, they turn their money into the snack shop during registration to set up an account and prevent theft/loss of monies. Parents will be able to pay online to set up a tab for their child

Things to Share With Your Campers

- 1) If you have special food restrictions/allergies be sure to communicate that clearly before you arrive at camp (by 5/15) so we can make arrangements for you.
- 2) Be sure to go over the camp rules so everyone will know what is expected when they arrive on campus.
- 3) Prescription medications are the responsibility of the leader of each group until groups gets to camp. Please give all medication instructions and handed off ALL MEDICATIONS to camp nurse at registration. to camp nurse when arriving at camp.
- 4) We know camp is a fun and safe place to meet the opposite sex, but NO PDA (Public Displays of Affection)

CAMP RULES

1. Every camper must follow the schedule.
2. No camper may leave the grounds without permission of a Camp Director.
Adult Leaders must inform a Camp Director if they are leaving the grounds for any reason.
3. No tobacco products, alcohol, or illegal substances are allowed on the camp grounds.
4. No camper is allowed outside of the cabins after lights out.
5. **DRESS CODE:**
 - A. Both boys & girls will be fully dressed at **all times**.
 - B. Shorts must be at least as long as the end of the finger tips when your hands are at your sides.
 - C. Shoes or flip flops are required to be worn at all times.
 - D. All tops, shirts, blouses, etc. should have sleeves or thick straps. No string straps.
 - E. Shirts must cover the midriff.
 - F. Swim suits: two piece suits must be covered with a swim shirt
6. **CELL PHONES**
 - A. Cell phones may be used during free times.
 - B. Cell phones must be put away during small group, devotional time, and chapel services.
 - C. Cell phones may not be used after lights out.

ANY & ALL questions/concerns with a camper, leader, or staff member are to be taken to a Camp Director(s). Adult Leaders must set the example by following the same rules as the campers.

THINGS TO BRING TO CAMP: clothes, clothes for games, shoes, shower shoes, swim suits (bikinis must be covered with a swim shirt), toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, deodorant, towels & washcloths, pillow & linens/sleeping bag, flashlight, paper Bible, notebook & pencil/pen. Etc.
