

NBC Assimilation Process

When joining a new church it can often be difficult to know how to get involved at a deeper level. In Ephesians 4:11-13, Paul explains that the leaders of each local church are to equip the saints in their local congregation to use their gifts for the work of ministry. In light of that important mandate, the elders of NBC have designed this assimilation process to equip each member to use their gifts in our local body.

This process is not intended to be heavy-handed but is birthed out of a genuine desire to help foster deep fellowship, unity, service, and spiritual maturity in each member of our church according to the pattern given in Scripture.

General

1. Attend for a minimum of 1-3 months
2. Join a small group
3. Complete membership process
4. Serve in non-teaching roles
5. Complete Partners

Note: A background check will be required to work with minors.

Kids Teacher

Assumes completion of general

1. Serve with NBC Kids for 6 month minimum in non-teaching role
2. Attend NBC Kids teacher training
3. Approval of NBC ministry leader

Small Group Leader

Assumes completion of general

1. Recommendation by Partners leader
2. Recommendation by small group leader
3. Complete small group teacher training
4. Recommendation by small group ministry leader
5. A Leader in Training (*Elder Approval*)
6. Small Group Leader (*Elder Approval*)

Adult/Youth Leader

Assumes completion of general

1. Recommendation by Partners leader
2. Recommendation by small group leader
3. Complete teaching practicum
4. Affirmation of teaching gift by ministry leader
5. Teacher in training (*Elder Approval*)
6. Adult/Youth Teacher (*Elder Approval*)
