We're really glad you're stepping into this 40-day prayer journey with us. This whole thing grew out of an experience we had last year - forty days of intentionally slowing down, paying attention, and talking to God in a more honest way than our busy lives usually allow. We didn't expect how refreshing it would be. It helped us see His hand in ways we'd never expect, and it helped us keep building rhythms of listening to Him.

That's what we're hoping for you too. Over these forty days, we're asking everyone in our church to pray for a few big things.

First, as a church we're stepping into the next chapter for Heartland as we pursue going multi-site and moving toward East Madison. We want to invite you to pray for that community. Pray for its people, its schools, its families, and for what God might be inviting us into there.

We also want you to ask God if He might be calling you to be part of the launch team, and how you might play a role, spiritually, practically, and financially. We don't want to just rush ahead; we want to follow God's lead.

But these forty days aren't just about the church - they're about you too. There's something in your life that you're carrying right now. Something you're hoping for, or worried about, or needing direction in. We invite you to bring that with you into this journey. Make space for God to speak into it. Let these days help you build a pattern of prayer that actually fits into real life and makes a difference.

"Prayer" is our word for 2026, but honestly, it's more than a word. We want it to be the way we live. We want to be a community that actually trusts God enough to talk to Him, listen for Him, and say yes when He nudges us.

We can't wait to see all that He does.

Thanks for committing to these next forty days. Thanks for showing up with an open heart. We're with you in it, cheering you on, and praying alongside you.










