

Rock Youth Summer Camp 2024 | Packing List

Appearance & Attire: Campers should bring to camp clothing that is appropriate for an outdoor, active camp program.

What Not To Bring To Camp:

- Clothing with words, logos, or graphics depicting violence, sexual innuendos, drugs, alcohol, or inappropriate language or topics.
- Clothing or appearance that is distracting, unsafe, or inappropriate per camp's discretion.
- Clothing that does not cover garments and shorts that do not cover the camper's bottom.
- No laptops, gaming consoles, or portable games.
- No musical instruments.
- No pranking items.
- No animals.
- No weapon of any type. This includes knives, firearms, or gun objects.
- No illegal drugs, tobacco products, alcohol, or vape products.

Note: We will strictly enforce our dress code. We ask that parents supervise packing and make sure that no inappropriate clothing items are brought to camp. Your students are expected to abide by all camp rules. If they do not conduct themselves in a proper Godly manner, the leaders and staff have the right to send them home.

Note: Students are allowed to bring cell phones to camp. We do ask that cell phones be used only during appropriate times. If we see students on their phones during service or during group activities leaders do have the right to take phones away. If a student's phone is taken away parents will be notified and the phone will be returned upon our arrival back from camp.

What To Bring To Camp:

- Appropriate clothing, enough for 4 days.
- Pillow, sleeping bag, or sheets and blanket. The bed that students are sleeping on is a twin-size mattress.
- Swimwear. For girls: a one piece, but if wearing two piece they must wear a dark shirt/tank top over it.
- Beach & shower towel. Preferably separate towels.
- Appropriate sleepwear.
- Reusable water bottle.
- Shoes that would be appropriate for walking & running.
- Shower shoes.
- A lightweight jacket.
- Toiletries (Deodorant, Shampoo, Conditioner, Toothbrush, Toothpaste, etc.)
- Bible, journal, pen, or pencil.
- Spending money *snack bar on campus + camp merchandise (optional).
- Snacks (optional).

Note: Students participate in rec games every day. Often rec games include water. It is encouraged that your students pack an extra outfit or two in case they want to change after rec games.

Note: During rec games, the students are encouraged to dress in their team color. Our team colors this year are black and grey. To know what team your student is on please email the Rock Youth Team at "rockyouth@gotrock.org" and someone will get back to you shortly.

Note: On the last night of camp students are encouraged to dress up for "Campies". This is a fun time where tables are decorated for dinner, and leaders serve the students. Dinner will be followed by awards!
