


THE BIRTH OF MOSES - Exodus 2:1-10

What irony do we find in this part of the story?

MOSES THE DELIVERER, MURDERER, AND FUGITIVE - Exodus 2:11-22

- *Jethro has seven daughters; presumably no sons.*
- *He knows his daughters must deal with shepherds to water his flocks.*
- *His daughters and flocks come back early one day.*
- *They tell him an Egyptian DELIVERED them out of the hand of the shepherds.*
- *Invite this man to dinner!*



What repeated action does Moses do through this section of the story? What is displayed in his character?

UPDATE ON EGYPT - Exodus 2:23-25

God HEARS their groaning, REMEMBERS His covenant, SEES the people of Israel, and KNOWS.
 What does God know?
