**EXODUS 32:1 - 33:6 – "Sin In The Camp"**THE PEOPLE:

- Become \_\_\_\_\_
- \_\_\_\_\_ Aaron to make gods for them.
- Give Aaron the \_\_\_\_\_ he demands.
- Say, "These are your gods, O Israel, who brought you up from Egypt!"
- \_\_\_\_\_
