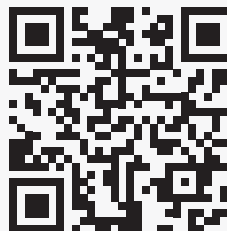

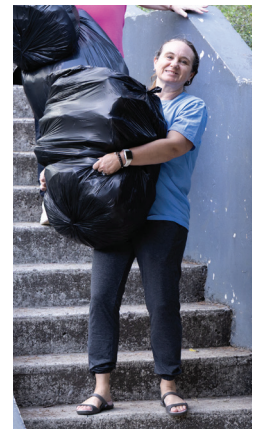

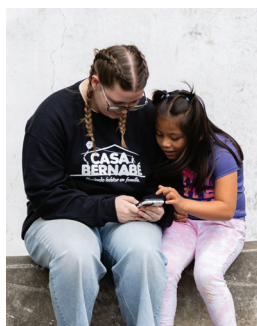
A Church on Mission in Guatemala

Love is woven into who we are as a church family—not just in what we say, but in how we go, give, and serve. Recently, Connection Point had the opportunity to live that out through a mission trip to Guatemala, serving at Casa Bernabé alongside church member and missionary Sara (Drake) Salguero and her husband Edgar.

This trip was made possible by the generosity and support of our entire church. Through donated supplies and financial gifts, our church family sent more than 15 suitcases filled with resources to bless the children and staff at Casa Bernabé. These donations included over 350 backpacks, 80 pairs of soccer cleats, school supplies, gifts for staff, and additional items to support daily life and learning. Financial gifts were also given to help purchase new textbooks for the school, investing in the children's education for the year ahead.

During the week, the team served as representatives of our church—helping distribute backpacks and keychains on the first day of school, providing snacks and fitting students for new soccer cleats, and painting classrooms in preparation for the school year. They also supported ongoing ministry through teaching dance classes, spending time with children, teaching and encouraging women, sharing testimonies, serving meals, and assisting with media and graphic design projects.

Casa Bernabé's mission is to provide hope and healing for vulnerable children in Guatemala. For more than 10 years, our church has partnered in this work, and we believe God will continue to use our collective gifts to serve faithfully. FIRST & FAST

Learning to Wait Well Together

Waiting is rarely easy. We like clarity, direction, and momentum. But throughout Scripture, waiting is often where God does some of His deepest work—shaping hearts, refining trust, and drawing His people closer to Himself. In seasons like the one we're in, waiting becomes an invitation to love God not by rushing ahead, but by staying present and dependent.

First & Fast is one of the ways we practice that kind of love together. Prayer and fasting help us slow our pace and reorient our hearts toward God. They remind us that our confidence isn't found in quick answers or perfect plans, but in the steady faithfulness of the One who leads us. Choosing to wait prayerfully is an act of trust—and trust is one of the clearest expressions of love.

This rhythm also forms us over time. Month after month, we gather to pray and fast not because everything is urgent, but because faithfulness matters. Love grows through consistency. As we return

again and again to prayer, God shapes us into a people who listen well, depend deeply, and remain united—even when the path forward unfolds slowly.

There is something powerful about waiting together. When we gather to pray, we're reminded that we're not carrying this season alone. We bring our hopes, concerns, and questions before God as one church family, trusting Him to guide us in His timing. That shared posture of humility and trust strengthens our love for God and for one another.

We invite you to join us for our First & Fast gatherings on the first Sunday of every month at 5:00pm in the Atrium, followed by a day of fasting on Monday. Come ready to pray, to listen, and to wait well—together.
