"God's People for God's Purpose"

Dear Church Family,

Have you ever considered "the why" and "the what" behind your purpose here? I'm not merely talking about what you do for a living, or the roles you fill, or the responsibilities you have

(though you can find great purpose and meaning in each of these if prayerfully considered), but I am speaking to the reason that God has created you, saved you, and placed you on earth for this moment in history. Your life's purpose is not random or by chance. Our days on earth are not coincidental or meaningless (Ephesians 2:10 & Psalm 139:16). God has a plan, but are we willing to align our lives with what He has in store? Will you consider His eternal purposes for your life on earth?

This is the theme that I believe

God would have us pursue in 2026: *God's People for God's Purposes.*



I recently read in a study by Avery T. Willis, Jr. that God doesn't want us to **work for Him**; rather, He wants to **work through us** (*MasterLife – The Disciples' Cross*, p. 46). If we're honest, many of us spend our years working hard with activity, full schedules, and doing many good things while quietly wondering if there is more to the life that God intends. If you are in a season of pursuing God's purpose for your life, or if you are diligently walking with Him in the journey He has designed for you, I believe this year's focus as a church will greatly enhance your clarity, deepen your faith, and equip and encourage you to walk confidently in God's purpose and calling for your life.

At Pittsboro Baptist Church, *we are a family of believers built on God's unchanging Word who are on mission together to reach the lost, disciple the believer, and to love others in the way of Christ so that they may know Him and follow Him.*

While God has given us more than we could ever imagine to accomplish this purpose as a church collectively, we will have a far greater impact together if everyone is pursuing God's purposes in their everyday lives. He has uniquely called you, gifted you, equipped you, and is sending you for His glory in many places of influence. The truth is we are the church on 121 West Salisbury Street, but also wherever the Lord leads you from day to day. My goal is to join you in discovering what that purpose may be. To accomplish this, we will investigate the life of Moses on Sunday mornings (beginning February 1st). Moses was a man who learned to listen for, respond to, and move with God's purposes for His life and for the people he led.

Together, we will:

- Discover how God had a purpose for Moses' life even before Moses recognized it (Exodus 1–2).
- Learn how Moses surrendered himself to God's purposes, despite his own inadequacies.
- Consider how God prepares us for the purposes He has for us (Exodus 2).
- Explore lessons in obedience and how it leads to fulfilling our purpose (Exodus 3 & 14).
- Ask God to prepare our hearts with perseverance, deepening our fellowship and growth with Him for the journey ahead (Exodus 32–34).
- See how our purpose can inspire future generations (Deuteronomy 34).

I know that God has something powerful He desires to do in us and through us as we take this journey together in the Scripture. I do not want to give the false impression that simply by attending one of our conferences or attending a worship service or two will immediately reveal God's purposes for your life. Discovering His purpose is not a one-time event, but a continual process of listening, learning, surrendering, trusting, abiding, and obeying Him. There have been seasons and continue to be moments in my life where I needed my Shepherd's faithful correction, encouragement, and realignment of what He wanted to do in my life above my own desires. He has been faithful to guide, equip, and use me even in my own weaknesses for His greater purposes.

I invite you to join me in this holy pursuit. Let's begin praying now individually and as a church family to seek God's purposes with open hearts. He has incredible plans for Pittsboro Baptist Church in 2026, and I am certain that this year could be our most fruitful yet. Will you take this next step with me? Let's obediently and confidently walk with God as His people for His purposes, trusting that he will lead us every step of the way.

"He Is Here"

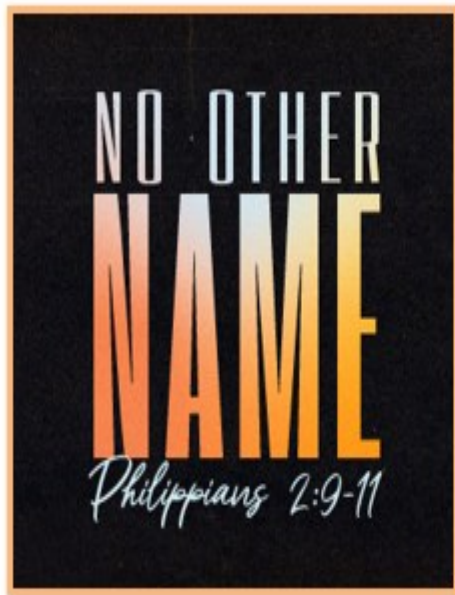

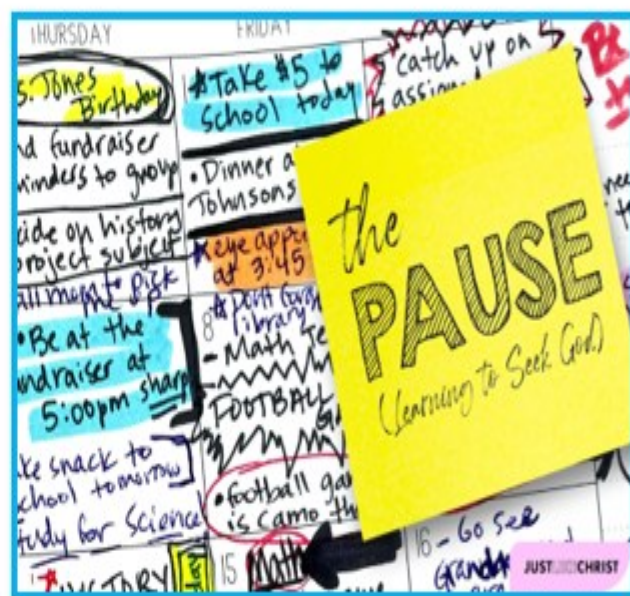

New 2026 Offering Envelopes are here!

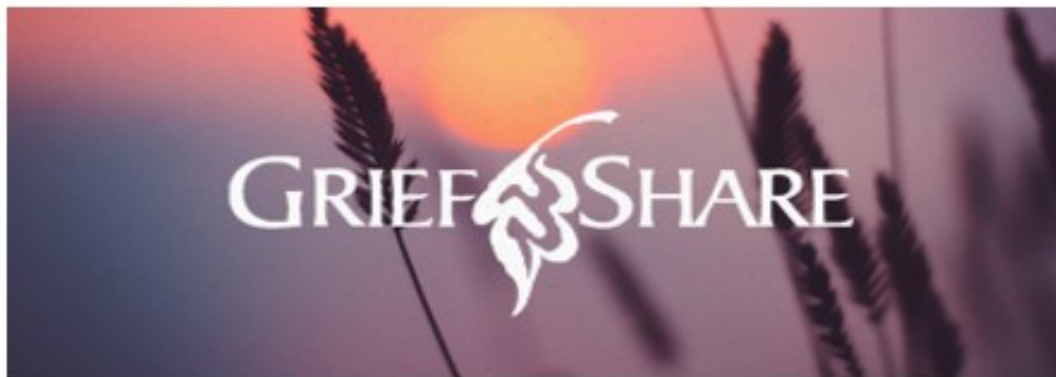

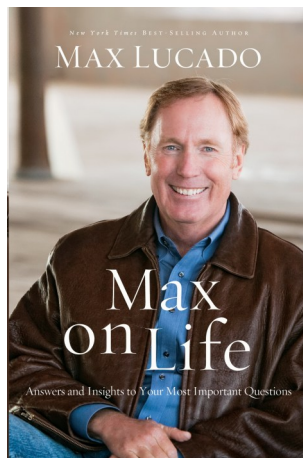

Max on Life by Max Lucado

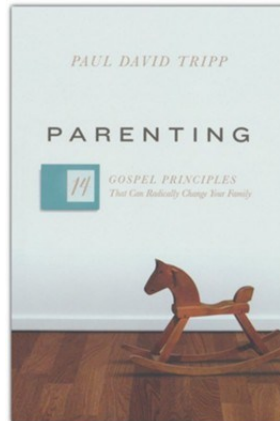
A special addendum includes Max's advice on writing and publishing.

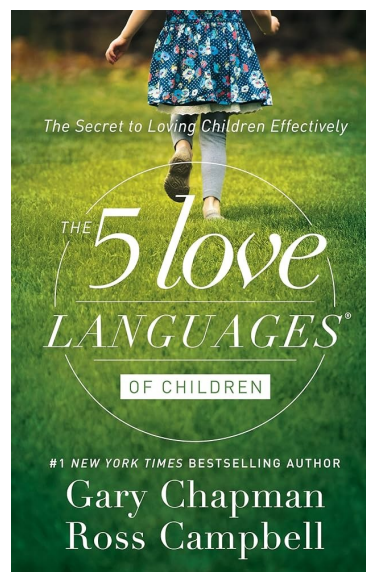
