1st - 3rd grade will meet for Kids worship UPSTAIRS during the entire second service. *Parents, please walk your kids up & pick up after.*


Ages 4th - 6th grade start in worship with adults and exit at the song or video just after communion to the classroom in the back hall, room 112.



