1 <i>Psalm 139:1-12</i> Heavenly Father, thank you for knowing us so completely and loving us always. We know you walk with us during all times. Lord lead us and we will follow, for you are our everlasting God. Amen.	2 <i>Jeremiah 29:11-12</i> Father, we know you have a perfect plan for us. Help us to put aside our fears and place all our faith and trust in you, knowing you would never harm us. Dear Lord, we know you will walk with us during times of hardship. We trust in you. Amen.	3 <i>2 Timothy 3:10-17</i> Gracious God, let us remain steadfast in your word even through opposition. Let us use your scriptures to guide us to lead a life that honors you. You have prepared us to faithfully serve you. Amen.	4 <i>Matthew 14:12-21</i> Lord teach us to trust in you, knowing that you will provide more than enough. Help us to see the need in others and to respond with love. Thank you for your compassion and your love. Amen.	5 <i>Psalm 23:1-6</i> Lord, you are our shepherd, and because of you, we lack nothing.
