3 Things Jesus Gives All Disciples

1. A Mission.

- *The Lord now chose seventy-two other disciples and sent them ahead in pairs to all the towns and places he planned to visit.*

—Luke 10:1 (NLT)

2. A Message.

- *Heal the sick who are there and tell them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.'*

—Luke 10:9 (NLT)

- *There are different kinds of spiritual gifts, but the same Spirit is the source of them all. There are different kinds of service, but we serve the same Lord. God works in different ways, but it is the same God who does the work in all of us. A spiritual gift is given to each of us so we can help each other.*

—1 Corinthians 12:4-7 (NLT)

- *You will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."*

—Acts 1:8 (NLT)

- *Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect.*

—1 Peter 3:15-16 (NLT)

3. An Attitude.

- *"If you enter a town and it welcomes you, eat whatever is set before you. Heal the sick, and tell*

them, 'The Kingdom of God is near you now.' But when you enter a town and are not welcomed, go into its streets and say, 'Even the dust of your town we wipe from our feet as a warning to you. Yet be sure of this: The kingdom of God has come near...' 'Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, Bethsaida! —Luke 10:8-13 (NLT)

- *When the disciples James and John saw this, they asked, "Lord, do you want us to call fire down from heaven to destroy them?" But Jesus turned and rebuked them. —Luke 9:54-55 (NIV)*

- *When the seventy-two disciples returned, they joyfully reported to him, "Lord, even the demons obey us when we use your name!" "I saw Satan fall from heaven like lightning! Look, I have given you authority over all the power of the enemy... But don't rejoice because evil spirits obey you; rejoice because your names are written in heaven." —Luke 10:17-20 (NLT)*

- *Then I saw a great white throne and him who was seated on it... And I saw the dead, great and small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Another book was opened, which is the book of life. And the dead were judged according to what they had done, as recorded in the books. —Revelation 20:11-12 (NIV)*

Follow Through Step:

Spend some time reflecting on the unique mission Jesus has given you and the message that only you can proclaim in a way that nobody else can. And most of all- reflect on your attitude while doing it all.
